In addition to corporate events, YVE is passionate about hosting and supporting not-for-profit and charity organisations, and also opens its doors to private and public groups and functions.

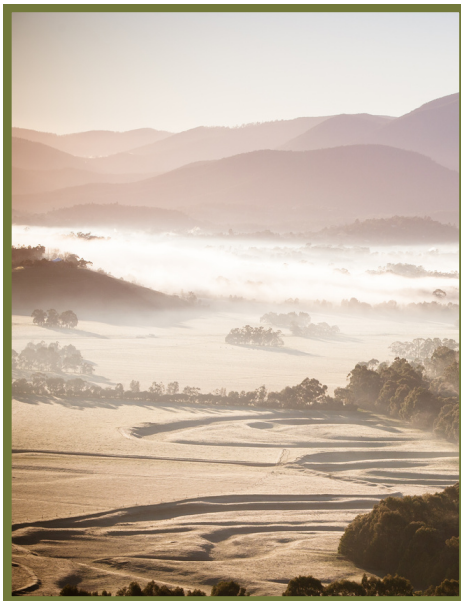

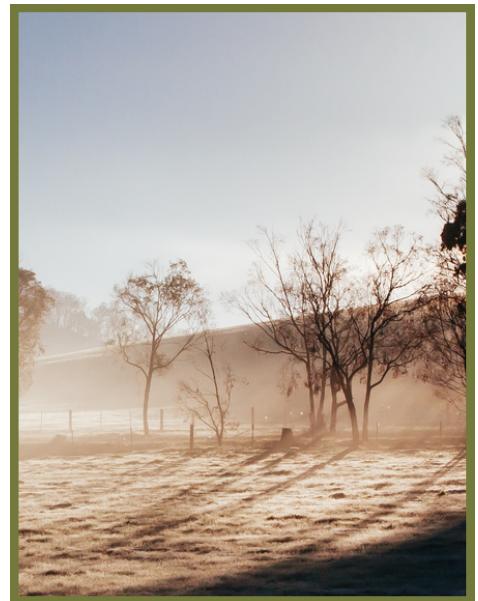
